

Nicholson Hall, University of Minnesota

Minneapolis, Minnesota (August 28, 2003) – Collaborative Design Group has recently begun design services for the rehabilitation of Nicholson Hall, a 110-year-old building designed by architect L.S. Buffington. The 68,000 sf building is located in the Historic Knoll District of the University of Minnesota Minneapolis Campus.

The building will be completely rehabilitated, including reconstruction of the foundation and floor structure, replacement of the slate roof and windows, all new mechanical and electrical systems, and reconfiguration of the building's interior. An auditorium addition constructed in 1946 will be demolished in order to add an outdoor courtyard.

The renovated facility is programmed to provide space for two academic units of the College of Liberal Arts, technology rich classrooms, a writing center, advising services, and student study space.
