

Collaborative Design Group Receives Design Awards

MINNEAPOLIS (May 20, 2004) –Collaborative Design Group is please to announce that two of their projects have received awards: the Rossmor Building in downtown St. Paul and Jeremiah Campus Community in Minneapolis.

The **Rossmor Building** won a First Place Honor Award, Residential, from the International Interior Design Association, (IIDA) Northland Chapter. Originally designed as a boot factory in 1918, the Rossmor's upper six stories have been converted to live/work units for artists and other creative tenants. The FAB Awards honor outstanding design and are given to recognize the best and brightest that the design and architectural industry has to offer. Earlier in the year, the Rossmor also won a First Place Best in Real Estate Award from the Minneapolis/St. Paul Business Journal.

Jeremiah Campus Community won a CUE Award from the City of Minneapolis Committee on Urban Environment (CUE). Jeremiah Campus Community is a 39 unit apartment building for single parent families to help themselves complete their education and achieve economic self sufficiency through access to affordable housing, onsite childcare, health care, support services and meaningful employment. CUE Awards are given to recognize excellence in urban, architectural, or environmental design, historic preservation, streetscapes, neighborhood improvement, parks and open spaces, public art, special events, and personal achievement.
